

HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN PUMPKIN ARRANGEMENT (WITH STICK-ON FACE)

Using AquaGems and BrightSpots

This jack-o-lantern arrangement is a unique alternative to a carved pumpkin for Halloween – and much easier to prepare, with less mess. Safe and simple for kids to create, too. Watch the accent lights bring the arrangement to life in bat caves, on porches, and in other dark surroundings!



What you will need:

- ONE LARGE CLEAR GLASS BOWL.
- SILK LEAVES.
- FLORAL WIRE.
- STICK-ON BLACK FOAM.
- AQUAGEMS. One 40-gram package of dry (or several bottles of hydrated) AquaGems in the color Sunstone (orange). If you use a small bowl, a 10-gram package of dry (or one bottle of hydrated) AquaGems may be enough.
- BRIGHTSPOTS. Use several of these submersible accent lights to create highlights.

Where to get these materials:

- Bowls, leaves, wire, and foam are available at your local craft store or florist or through online vendors. A variety of free stencils are available online. Don't hesitate to use materials that you already have at home.
- AquaGems and BrightSpots are manufactured by AquaGems of Idaho, LLC.

How to prepare:

1. If you have bought the dry form of AquaGems, you will need to place them in a water-filled container and allow 4 to 6 hours for the Gems to hydrate (see instructions on the packaging). You can use the glass bowl for this purpose. If you have bought the bottled form, your Gems are fully hydrated and ready for use immediately.
2. Cut out the foam into pieces for a jack-o-lantern face (see arrangement pictured). Place the pieces on the bowl.
3. Fill the bowl with the hydrated AquaGems.
4. Turn on the BrightSpots and push them down into the AquaGems.
5. Top off your pumpkin by tying the wire around the stems of your silk leaves and placing the stems down into the AquaGems.

Note: After Halloween, allow the AquaGems to dehydrate and save them. Next Halloween, add water to rehydrate them and re-create the same arrangement. You can repeat the process for years to come.
